## SEEKING A NEW HOME FOR KEW BIG AXE AND LOGS

Port Macquarie Hastings-Council is seeking community input into suggestions for a suitable site to relocate the large axe and two large logs currently situated on Council land at 133 Nancy Bird Walton Drive in Kew (adjoining the former Kew Visitor Information Centre).

Due to the size of these items (axe over 6 metres, cedar log 9 metres and tallowood log over 32 metres) the new site should be large enough so as the public may safely view them and include room for the parking of vehicles. These items are symbolic of the timber heritage of the region and for this reason a location in either Kew or Kendall is considered appropriate.

Port Macquarie Hastings-Council is seeking community input into the concept designs for the new All Abilities Playground for Bain Park. View the design concepts on Friday, 10th February 2012 between 4pm-6pm at Bain Park, Wauchope.

The landscape architect and Council staff will be available to discuss the concept plans.

Port Macquarie-Hastings Council received a \$100,000 Federal Government grant for the creation of a community space in Wauchope, designed specifically to be accessed by people of varied physical abilities. The funding will contribute to the design and construction of an all abilities playground in Bain Park and construction of a ramp and improved access at the Community Arts Centre adjacent to the park.

The grant will be matched by \$115,000 from Council. The intent of the Accessible Communities initiative is to improve the accessibility of community life for people with a disability.
