KEEP IT CLEAN AND YOU COULD WIN!

The 2010 Osmosis photography, digital images and poetry competition is now open. This year's theme *Keep It Clean* will allow entrants to explore water's life-giving qualities and the community's responsibility to conserve it and keep it clean.

The competition, now in its eighth year, is open to Hastings residents of all ages and is funded by Port Macquarie-Hastings Council as part of its program of educating the broader community about water conservation and environmental sustainability.

Photographers and writers are encouraged to explore the *Keep it Clean* theme as a celebration of our clean water and as a reminder of our responsibility to keep our waterways clean for the future health of our community. This year's competition offers great imaginative scope as we've now included a category for digitally created and enhanced imagery.

Those who participate have the chance of winning part of the \$1,600 in prize money, having their work exhibited during Hastings Water Week in October, as well as published in the 2011 Osmosis calendar.

Entry is free. Entries will be received at Council offices in Port Macquarie, Wauchope and Laurieton from Monday, 9 August until Monday 16 August between 8.30am - 4.00pm.

Winners will be announced during Water Week celebrations in October at the launch of the Osmosis 2011 calendar. All money raised from the sale of the Osmosis calendar is donated to WaterAid Australia for clean water projects in developing countries.



AERIAL SPRAYING BITOU BUSH – JUNE 2010

Port Macquarie-Hastings Council will be undertaking aerial spraying of Bitou Bush in June 2010 in the following areas:

- Pelican Point to Broken Bit, North Shore Beach,
- Christmas Bells Plains – Lighthouse Beach, Lake Cathie,
- Grants Knob, Bonny Hills; and
- South Rainbow Beach, Bonny Hills.

Weather permitting, aerial spraying will be conducted on Tuesday, 8 June, between 6am and 4:30pm. In the advent of inclement weather on Tuesday, aerial spraying will be conducted on the next available day within the period of Wednesday 9 to Friday 11 June. Public access around the above areas will be closed on the day of aerial spraying and signage and barricades will be erected on site.

Beach accesses on Lighthouse Beach, Rainbow Beach, Grants Knob, and North Shore Beach will be closed during the day of aerial spraying.

Three kilometres of Ocean Drive at Lake Cathie and Plomer Road, south of Corilla Estate, will be intermittently closed for periods of up to 20mins between the hours of 9am and 3pm on the day of aerial spraying. Traffic Control will be put in place to regulate the flow of traffic in this area.

All works are being undertaken by suitably qualified contractors and the program is designed to reduce and control the growth of Bitou Bush within coastal native plant communities.

- Herbicides to be used: Roundup 360 and Roundup Biactive;
- Active Ingredient: Glyphosate 360g/L;
- Licence and Permits: DECCW S12188, APVMA Permit: PER-8468
