## CALL FOR INTEREST: SHARED FOOD PROCESSING FACILITY

Port Macquarie-Hastings Council is calling for interested businesses in the retail, hospitality, wine, tourism and farming industries, who have value-adding as a key part of their growth strategy, to trial a Shared Use Kitchen Incubator (SUKI) located in the canteen area at St Columba Anglican College. The facility aims to attract early stage businesses that need a low cost option to process or prepare their food in an approved facility. During this incubation phase, a range of small business assistance will be provided. After the incubation period, when the business is established, tenants will move into their own premises.
