### WHIZZY'S SUMMER WATER TOUR

Whizzy the Waterdrop has an important message to share with Hastings residents this January.

Port Macquarie-Hastings Council's water-saving ambassador Whizzy the Waterdrop commenced his summer water conservation tour this week offering helpful water saving tips and hints to residents and visitors.

Whizzy will be on the road with Council's water team every Wednesday throughout January visiting Port Macquarie, Laurieton, Wauchope and Kendall swimming pools as well as some of our most popular tourist beaches and parks between the Camden Haven and Town Beach, Settlement City and the Town Green Bottle Bubbler.

Whizzy's tour dates are: Wednesday, January 12th, 19th and 26th commencing at 9.30am from Port Macquarie Town Beach.

### CHANGES TO CBD PARKING

As of January 6 the Hayward Street carpark in Port Macquarie has been closed due to construction of the new Coles supermarket.

Residents are advised that all day parking is available in nearby Gore, Bridge, Hollingworth and Buller Streets. Council is currently marking additional parking spaces in these streets.

The existing Coles carpark in Short and Hayward Streets remains a free carpark but has had three hour time limits applied to all bays as of Monday 4th January.

There is a grace period in relation to the timed parking. Council will advise motorists by letter when the grace period is to end and when the issue of fines for overstaying will commence.

### 2030 COMMUNITY FORUMS IN FEBRUARY

Community feedback is going to be a vital component of Council agreeing the level of work and rating structure for the next four years and Hastings residents can have their say in February.

A full suite of planning documents, including Community Strategic Plan, four year Delivery Program and the one year Operational Plan, went on public exhibition in November.

Submissions for the Towards 2030 Integrated Planning documents close on 28 February 2011, with community information session planned for 10th and 11th of February.

Details will appear on Council's website and in local media.
