



LIBRARY CLOSURE

All three Council libraries will be closed on Friday, 19th August 2011 to prepare for the introduction of a new RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) system.

The new system will allow patrons to use a self-check kiosk to borrow books. Initially these kiosks will only be available at Port Macquarie Library.

The closure will allow staff to be fully trained on the new system which will be introduced on Monday, 22nd August 2011.

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE: KING CREEK ROAD

In accordance with Section 115 of the Roads Act 1993, a temporary road closure of King Creek Road is planned between Narran Close and Sarahs Crescent from 29th August to 30th September 2011.

The road closure is necessary to allow for construction works currently underway in King Creek Road.

The road closure and traffic detour via Bago Road and the Oxley Highway will be signposted.

STINGRAY CREEK BRIDGE - SITE INVESTIGATIONS

Site investigations to assist the preparation of detailed designs for the replacement of the Stingray Creek bridge have commenced and are expected to continue throughout the design phase up until November 2011.

The site investigations will generally occur within the waterways and adjoining public roads and reserves and involve land surveying, drilling for soil samples and location of existing utility services.
