BUSHFIRE RISK MITIGATION POLICY FOR PORT MACQUARIE-HASTINGS COUNCIL OWNED AND MANAGED LAND

Port Macquarie-Hastings Council has developed a new Bushfire Risk Mitigation policy to provide clear guidelines for assessment and mitigation of bushfire risk on public land whilst preserving the Local Government Area's (LGA) natural amenity and environmental values. The risk of damaging bushfires on council owned or managed land is mitigated by fuel management and other fire protection measures.

The policy will be on exhibition from 29th April 2011 to
