WEST HAVEN AND LAURIETON – SEWER LINE TESTING

Council will commence sewer line testing in West Haven and Laurieton at the end of August as a part of a program to detect any defects in the public sewer and house service lines. Council has engaged the Regional Australian Infiltration Network (RAIN) to undertake smoke testing from Tuesday, 25 August. The program should be finalised within 8 weeks. During smoke testing, a harmless white vapour will be injected into the sewer system to locate leaks. The vapour may be seen coming from manhole covers, storm drains, roof vents and building formations. The 'smoke' is a harmless vegetable oil that is atomised to form a dense, environmentally-friendly mist. The mist will follow the path of the leak to the ground surface or above-ground outlet, revealing the source of the problem.
