



TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES: ANZAC DAY MARCHES PORT MACQUARIE, WAUCHOPE AND LAURIETON MONDAY 25 APRIL 2011

Notice is hereby given for the temporary road closures in the central business districts of Port Macquarie, Wauchope and Laurieton for ANZAC Day on Monday, 25th April 2011.

Road will be closed between 9.30am and 11.30am except for the northern section of Horton Street (Town Green) which will be closed from 6.30am.

Port Macquarie Road Closures

Horton Street, between Hayward Street and the Town Green, while Clarence Street and William Street will be closed to through traffic at Horton Street. The Taxi Zone in Horton Street will be temporarily relocated to the Glasshouse bus zone in Clarence Street.

Laurieton Road Closures

Seymour Street, between Wharf Street and Bold Street; Bold Street and Kew Road between Laurie Street and Castle Street while Seymour Street and Tunis Street will be closed to through traffic at Bold Street.

Wauchope Road Closures

Cameron Street between Young Street and High Street; High Street between Cameron Street and Hastings Street while Bransdon Street and Oxley Lane will be closed to through traffic to High Street.
