## ARTS AND CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT SUB-COMMITTEE OUTCOME GROUP MEMBERSHIP

Expressions of Interest (EOI) are being sought from the community to join one of three new Arts and Cultural Development Sub-Committee Outcome Groups. Each Outcome Group will focus on one of the following cultural events held in the Port Macquarie-Hastings region on a bi-annual basis.

**AquaSculpture:** AquaSculpture is an exhibition of temporary sculptural and performance works. The event aims to develop as a sustainable public art event which animates the Hastings River foreshore, encourages experimentation in public art, provides a vehicle for expression of community creativity and raises awareness about water quality and catchment management issues.

**FreshArt:** FreshArt gives young artists aged 12-25 the opportunity to exhibit their artworks to a wider community audience and for young people to take part in various workshops related to the creative arts.

**PlayRites:** PlayRites Festival of Theatre is a quality contemporary theatre festival which brings contemporary theatre to the Region utilising both local and non-local presenters.
