TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES ANZAC DAY MARCHES PORT MACQUARIE, WAUCHOPE AND LAURIETON MONDAY 25 APRIL 2011

Notice is hereby given for the temporary road closures in the central business districts of Port Macquarie, Wauchope and Laurieton on ANZAC Day Monday, 25th April 2011.

Roads will be closed between 9.30am and 11.30am except for the northern section of Horton Street (Town Green) which will be closed from 6.30am.

Port Macquarie Road Closures: The temporary closure of Horton Street, between Hayward Street and the Town Green, and the closure of Clarence Street and William Street to through traffic at Horton Street. The Taxi Zone in Horton Street will be temporarily relocated to the Glasshouse bus zone in Clarence Street.

Laurieton Road Closures: The closure of Seymour Street, between Wharf Street and Bold Street; the closure of Bold Street and Kew Road between Laurie Street and Castle Street; and the closure of Seymour Street and Tunis Street to through traffic at Bold Street.

Wauchope Road Closures: The closure of Cameron Street between Young Street and High Street; the closure of High Street between Cameron Street and Hastings Street; and the closure of Bransdon Street and Oxley Lane to through traffic to High Street.
