



ROADWORKS: HORTON STREET BETWEEN HAYWARD AND GORDON STREETS, 26TH JUNE 2011

Council is planning to carry out Asphalt Resurfacing Works on the southbound section of Horton St between Hayward St and Gordon St. To minimise disruption to local businesses Council has scheduled this work For Sunday afternoon, 26th June 2011. Works are proposed to start at 12 noon and should be complete by 9pm. During this time this section of road will be under traffic control and minor delays will be encountered.

ROADS ACT 1993, ROADS REGULATION 2008, NAMING OF PUBLIC ROADS

Households can recycle unwanted electronic items in July across the mid north coast at an e-waste collection day hosted by Midwaste Regional Waste Forum and Port Macquarie-Hastings Council.

Residents can take unwanted computer, television, entertainment and home office equipment to the free drop off point located at the Player's Theatre carpark in Port Macquarie between 9:00am and 4:00pm.

Council welcomes residents living in surrounding areas to take advantage of this valuable service.

With increasing developments in technology, many electronic items become obsolete and unwanted. This collection offers everyone a great opportunity to clean out these goods from their cupboards and ensure they are disposed of correctly.

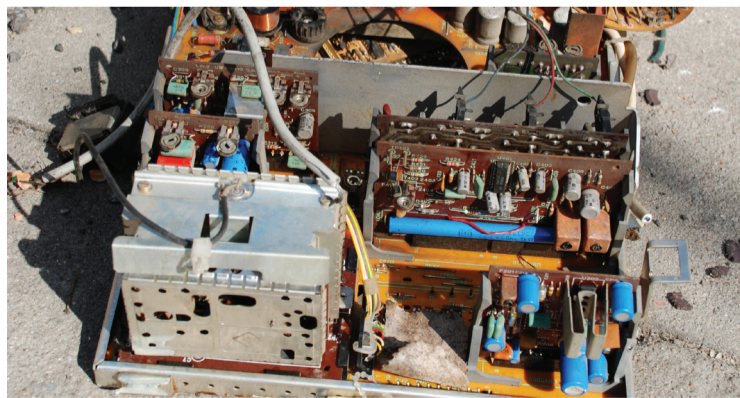
E-waste doesn't belong in the bin. Keeping e-waste out of landfill helps prevent hazardous substances such as lead, mercury and chromium potentially leaching into soil and groundwater. In addition, the recycling process saves valuable energy and the need to extract natural resources required to make new products.

All items collected on the day will be manually dismantled in Australia and their components (including plastic, metals and glass) sent for recycling.

The collection is being hosted as part of a regional e-waste blitz coordinated by Apple Pty Ltd. The drop off at Player's Theatre carpark in Port Macquarie is just one of five sites across the Mid North Coast that will be operating on the weekend of July 23rd and 24th.

Schools and other educational institutions can arrange to drop off e-waste on Friday, 22nd July.
