## PRELIMINARY HERBICIDE SPRAYING ADVICE: BROADLEAF AND BINDII WEED CONTROL PROGRAM

Port Macquarie-Hastings Council will be spraying selected parks, reserves and sporting fields for the control of broadleaf weeds and Bindii during August and September 2011. The program is designed to reduce the presence of these weeds within Council's open space turf areas.

Weed control will be undertaken at Port Macquarie, Comboyne, Lake Cathie, Kendall, North Shore, Wauchope, Laurieton, Beechwood, Dunbogan, Ellenborough, North Haven, Long Flat, West Haven, Pembroke, Telegraph Point and Sancroix.

**Herbicides proposed to be used:** Javelin®

**Active ingredients:** 300g/L MCPA; 20 g/L Clopyralid; 15 g/L Diflufenican; Broadleaf Weeder®; 326 g/L Mecoprop; 77 g/L MCPA and 39 g/L Dicamba.

All spraying activities will be undertaken by fully qualified staff and will only be conducted during suitable weather conditions.

## EXTENSION OF EXHIBITION PERIOD: DRAFT AMENDMENT TO PORT MACQUARIE-HASTINGS DEVELOPMENT CONTROL PLAN 2011 AND DRAFT SETTLEMENT CITY PRECINCT SECTION 94 ROADS CONTRIBUTIONS PLAN

Council has prepared a draft amendment to the General Provisions of Port Macquarie-Hastings Development Control Plan (DCP) 2011 to incorporate public art and additional advertising/signage provisions applicable to the Port Macquarie-Hastings Local Government Area.

The draft amendment also proposes Area Specific Provisions for the progressive development of land within the Settlement City Precinct located north of Wariters Street, Port Macquarie over the next 10 to 15 years.

In addition, a draft Section 94 Contributions Plan has been prepared to specify the level of developer contributions that will apply in relation to road and intersection works to accommodate future development in the Settlement City Precinct.

The draft DCP provisions, draft Section 94 Plan and supporting information is on public exhibition until close of business Friday, 16th September 2011.

During this period the draft documents and accompanying information are available for inspection in the foyer of Council's Port Macquarie, Wauchope and Laurieton offices between the hours of 8:30am and 4:30pm, Monday to Friday.
