PORT MACQUARIE-HASTINGS DEVELOPMENT CONTROL PLAN 2011

Council has prepared an amendment to Development Control Plan 2011.

The amendment introduces Area Based Provisions for Lot 1 DP827937, 370 Ocean Drive, West Haven and proposes changes to the Area Based Provisions - Port Macquarie Town Centre applying to Block 11. The draft provisions and supporting material may be inspected during normal business hours at Council's Customer Service Centre in Burrawan Street, Port Macquarie and Laurieton office up to the closing date for submissions on 28th June 2011.

During the above period any person may make a submission in writing to Council in relation to the draft provisions. Where a submission is made by way of objection, the grounds of the objection are required to be specified. Any submission may be reproduced in full in Council reports or disclosed upon request under the Government Information (Public Access) Act. Also, disclosure of a political donation or gift is required by a person or their associate when making a submission. Please provide a full return address and telephone number when making a submission to enable Council to inform you of progress of the development control plan.

On 25th May 2011, Council approved the Area Based Provisions for Area 15. These have now been included in Port Macquarie-Hastings Development Control Plan 2011 but do not commence until such time as the amendment to Port Macquarie-Hastings Local Environmental Plan 2011 to rezone Area 15 is published on the NSW Legislation website.
